ENTERING THE GROUP ZONE

1. When you hear someone say, "I'm so blessed," what kinds of things do you usually picture?
 - Does what comes to mind align with the New Testament’s use of being blessed?
2. Often, we feel blessed when things are going well (good health, comfort, income, etc.). Compare this “blessed” feeling to a time you went through hardships or suffering—did you feel blessed then also? Explain.
3. Complete this statement: “I feel most blessed when...”
4. Have you felt “blessed” because of your faith, salvation, or relationship with God, even when circumstances are difficult? Share your experience.
5. Looking back at this week’s message, was there anything that particularly challenged you, confused you, or caught your attention?

DIGGING DEEPER

1. Read 1 Peter 4:12-14. Peter says not to be surprised by "fiery trials" and that you are blessed if insulted for Christ's name. How do these words reflect Jesus' words in Matthew 5:11-12?
 - How does knowing that trials are opportunities for spiritual blessing change your perspective towards trials and difficulties?
2. Read Romans 8:35–39. Which of the hardships listed in these verses have you experienced? In what ways was the hardship a blessing?
 - Though the word “blessed” is not used in these verses, what is the great blessing that’s emphasized or inferred in these verses?
 - How do these verses show that the true blessing is in a relationship, not in circumstances?

TAKING IT HOME

This week, how will knowing that the true blessing is about your relationship with God, not about what you have, change your perspective and the way you live?
