DIGGING DEEPER

2. Paul, before talking about the fruit of the Spirit, wrote Galatians 5:13-14. Read these two verses and share how we are supposed to serve one another. Why are humility and love important to service?
 - Describe what serving at church may look like without having a mindset as Jesus: one of love and humility.
3. Read 1 Peter 4:8–11. How do these verses show us the mindset of Jesus—serving others with both humility and love?

TAKING IT HOME
