DIGGING DEEPER

- 3. Continue reading in the same chapter: read 1 Corinthians 12:21-26. How does Paul respond to those who may think that some behind-the-scenes serving jobs do not matter or are not important? What lessons do we learn?
 - Give examples of areas of service in the church that may be considered less honorable. How should our attitude be towards those who serve in those areas?
